Access to Previous Decisions

- 1. The Tribunal maintains a database of previous decisions of the International Protection Appeals Tribunal and the Refugee Appeals Tribunal.
- All matters in a decision which would tend to identify a person as an applicant for refugee status have been redacted, so that the identity of applicants is kept confidentials.
- 3. Any person may access2 the database for any lawful purpose.
- 4. It may not be possible to place certain decisions in the database in circumstances where the Chairperson of the Tribunal is of the opinion that the identity of an applicant cannot be sufficiently protected by redacting information from the decision.
